CLIMATE ACTION PLAN

This Climate Action Plan sets out Rathfinny Wine Estate's approach to measuring, reducing and transparently reporting its climate impacts. The Plan supports the Estate's Environmental Policy and Environmental Action Plan and is designed to meet the requirements of B Corp Climate Action criteria CA 2.1.

OUR COMMITMENT

Rathfinny Wine Estate is committed to understanding, reducing and transparently reporting the environmental impacts of its activities across the Estate, Winery and Vineyard. Addressing climate change is inseparable from protecting biodiversity, improving soil health and building long-term ecosystem resilience.

MEASURING OUR IMPACT

The Estate measures and reports its full Scope 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas emissions annually, using internationally recognised methodologies including the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard and Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard. Carbon footprint reporting is undertaken with independent third-party support and reviewed annually to ensure consistency, accuracy and continuous improvement.

Annual carbon reports are published on the Estate's website to ensure transparency and accountability.

REDUCING EMISSIONS

Rathfinny takes a practical, data-led approach to reducing emissions over time. Actions include improving energy efficiency across buildings and operations; investing in renewable energy generation, including solar panels at the Winery; reducing energy and water use where possible; minimising waste and improving recycling and reuse; and embedding sustainability into procurement and supplier decision-making.

Environmental actions are reviewed and updated annually through carbon reporting, Environmental Policy commitments, and wider environmental management processes.

LONG-TERM CLIMATE GOALS

Rathfinny Wine Estate is a signatory to the UNFCCC Race to Zero campaign, committing to help limit global warming to 1.5°C. The Estate's stated ambitions are to halve greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 and achieve Net Zero by 2050. These commitments guide long-term investment, land management and operational decision-making.

BIODIVERSITY & SOIL HEALTH

The Estate's climate approach extends beyond carbon alone. Biodiversity monitoring is undertaken across the Estate to understand habitats and ecological value over time, and soil data is collected at vineyard block

level, including soil organic carbon metrics. This information supports regenerative viticulture, evidence-based land management and long-term ecosystem resilience.

GOVERNANCE AND OVERSIGHT

Responsibility for climate action sits within the Estate's overall governance framework. This Climate Action Plan is reviewed by the Estate's highest governing body to ensure oversight, accountability and alignment with the Estate's long-term strategy. Climate-related performance and progress are considered as part of broader business and environmental decision-making.

REVIEW CYCLE

This Climate Action Plan will be formally reviewed at least once every 36 months, and more frequently where significant changes to operations, methodology or best practice occur. Annual carbon measurement and reporting inform interim reviews and continuous improvement.

TRANSPARENCY

Rathfinny Wine Estate is committed to transparency. Carbon reporting, climate commitments and progress are publicly available, and this Climate Action Plan is reviewed periodically to ensure it remains accurate, relevant and credible.
